SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

These Supplementary Sailing Instructions must be read in conjunction with the NOR and the GHYC Standard SI's

1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 1.1 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 4 minutes' in the race signal AP. This changes RRS Race Signals AP

2 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 2.1 The Schedule will be as described in the NOR

3 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be: Squib – Code Flag Numeral 1

Dragon – Code Flag D

4 RACING AREA AND MARKS

- 4.1 The racing area will be between Glandore Harbour and Castletownshend Harbour

5 THE COURSES

The Course for the two classes will be as follows:-

5.1 Glandore to Castletownshend

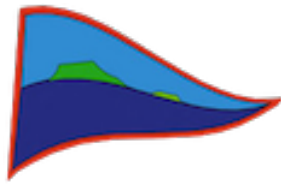
5.1.1 Squibs – Start GHYC Red Limit S, Skeddy Island S, Finish

5.1.2 Dragons - Start GHYC Red Limit S, Rabbit Island S, High Island S, Skeddy Island S, Finish

5.2 Castletownshend to Glandore

5.2.1 Squibs – Start, Skeddy Island P, Finish Red Outer Limit P.

5.2.2 Dragons - Start, Skeddy Island P, Finish Red Outer Limit P.



6 THE START

The Start is defined as the GHYC Start and the Castletownshend Start, as follows:-

6.1 GHYC Start

6.1.1 The starting line will be the line between A moveable shore based red staff with a yellow reflective top and a flagged outer limit mark as described in Addendum 2 – Starting Flags & Notes of the Standard SI's. An inner distance mark, red buoy with pole, may be positioned on or near the shore side of the line. Boats shall start between the flagged limit mark and the inner distance mark at the final crossing of the Start Line... . . .

6.2 Castletownshend Start

6.2.1 The Castletownshend Harbour Start line will be the line between the South-easterly end of a building on the Eastern shore of Castletownshend Harbour and the location of the GHYC Race Officer on the western shore.



7 THE FINISH

The Finish is defined as the GHYC Finish and the Castletownshend Finish, as follows:-

7.1 GHYC Finish

7.1.1 The finishing line will be the same as the start line as described in 6.1.1 and use the Red Outer Limit

7.2 Castletownshend Finish

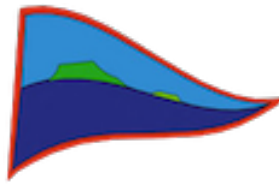
7.2.1 The Finishing line will be the same as the Start line as described in 6.2.1

7.3 Boats that have finished shall not re-cross the finishing line in any direction except for some unavoidable cause. The Race Committee will award a DSQ to any Boat that does. This changes RRS 60.

8 TIME LIMITS

8.1 The Race Time Limit will be 180 minutes

9.1 To Castletownshend: 1st Past the Post

9.1.1 Dragons - The Mary Anne's Perpetual Shield for Glandore to Castletownshend Yacht Race, which was originally presented in 1986.

9.1.2 Squibs - A new Mary Anne's trophy

9.2 To Castletownshend: RYA NHC Handicap Prize

9.2.1 Dragons – Handicap Prize to Helm and Crew of RYA NHC Handicap (Excluding the winner of the 1st Part the Post)

9.2.2 Squibs - Handicap Prize to Helm and Crew of RYA NHC Handicap (Excluding the winner of the 1st Part the Post)

The prizes will be awarded in Mary Anne's Bar at approximately 15:00hrs.

9.3 Return to Glandore

9.3.1 Dragons - 3 lobsters

9.3.2 Squibs - 2 lobsters
