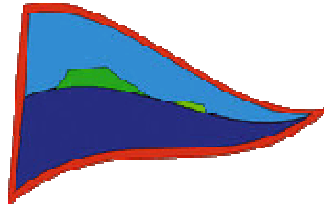

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organising Authority

Glandore Harbour Yacht Club.

2. Rules.

This Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association and any amendments thereto. Dragons carrying a VHF will comply with the local Sailing Rules. Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times when afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This changes rule 40.

All garbage to be disposed in accordance with Marpol Annex V

3. Eligibility & Entry

The event is open to the following classes: International Dragon

All boat owners and helms, except visitors to Glandore, must be paid up members of the Glandore Harbour Yacht Club. All boat owners shall be paid up members of their National Dragon Association. Entries will be accepted on line at <http://glandoreyc.com/> or at Registration on Saturday 20th August at 10.30 to 11.30, in writing by completing and signing the official entry form and paying the entry fee of €50.00. Payment may also be made by club members through EPP.

For visiting boats temporary membership of the GHYC is granted for the duration of the championship.

4. Category

World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code will apply.

5. Sailing Instructions.

Sailing Instructions will be available in the GHYC at registration.

Skipper's briefing will be held at 11.00hrs, Saturday 19th August at the GHYC Club House

6. Schedule of Races

Saturday, 19th, three races. First race scheduled at 13.00.

Sunday, 20th, two races. First race scheduled at 12.00.

There will be no warning signal after 15.30 on Sunday the 20th August.

7. Course

The Racing area will be in the waters of Glandore Harbour and Bay.

The courses to be sailed in Glandore Harbour and Bay will be detailed in the SIs.

8. Scoring.

If 3 or less races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

If 4 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Berthing and Hauling Out.

A crane will be available on the pier at Keelbeg, Union Hall, for launching on Saturday 19nd August 0900 – 1100 and for retrieving on Sunday, 20th August from 1600.

Launching and retrieving fee is 100 euros.

10. Insurance

Each boat's owner(s) and competing crews shall ensure that they are adequately insured against loss, damage or injury to persons, boats or equipment at all times and however occurring and shall maintain adequate insurance cover for racing risks. All Owners/competitors who enter are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

11. Liability

No responsibility shall be accepted by the Glandore Harbour Yacht Club, their directors, officers, members servants or agents nor any sponsor, nor those officials or members connected with the event for any loss, damage or any other claim of whatever nature however arising or caused in connection with the participation in or intended participation in the Rose Bowl.

12. Responsibility

The safety of the Boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge whose obligation is to ensure that the Boat is fully sound, seaworthy and is manned by an experienced crew with all the required safety gear. Neither this Notice of race nor the Sailing Instructions nor any action by the Glandore Harbour Yacht Club's Organising Committee in any way limits the responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge. Attention is drawn to RRS 4 Part 1 Fundamental Rules.

13. Prizes.

Prizes will be awarded to the helmsman and crew of the first three boats overall, and to the winner of each race, except that no helm and crew may win more than one race winner prize.

Presentations will take place in front of the Glandore Inn.

14. Accommodation

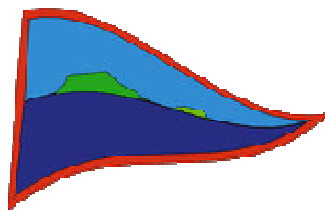
