NOTICE OF RACES

1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Under RRS 87 Squib class rule C10.2(b) is in effect
- 1.3 A boats handicap will be adjusted, using RYA NHC, after every race. A system of progressive handicapping, where each boat's handicap is automatically adjusted on the basis of performance in each race, will apply to each subsequent race. The act of handicap adjustment or failure to adjust will not be grounds for a request for redress this changes RRS Rule 62.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the Squib and Dragon classes whose owner is a paid-up members of GHYC.
- 2.2 Helms must be paid up members of GHYC
- 2.3 Entries are only accepted on successful completion of the attached Entry Form, which must be delivered to the GHYC Club house with the Fees required for the Event

3 FEES


3.1 Required fees are as follows:3.1.1 Squibs €20 & Dragons €25

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration: The Online payment is received no later than 23:59 on Friday 1st June, the completed and signed Entry form should also be sent to the Class Captain within the same time frame. Or

- 4.2 Registration will take place in the GHYC Club house between 10:00 and 10:30 on Saturday 2nd June
- 4.3 Racing Schedule:-
 - 4.3.1 Saturday 2nd June
 - 4.3.1.1 Squib FG will be 11:40
 - 4.3.1.2 Dragon FG will be 11:50
 - 4.3.2 Sunday 3rd June

A Note about the following FG times, as it is very likely that the visiting boats from KYC will have a FG at 09:55.

- The First Gun as detailed in 4.3.2.1 below will be the <u>same</u> sound as the Start Sound for the visiting boats at 10:00
- The First Gun as detailed in 4.3.2.2 below will be the <u>same</u> sound as for the Start Sound for the GHYC Squibs
 - 4.3.2.1 Squib FG will be 10:00
 - 4.3.2.2 Dragon FG will be 10:05

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Supplementary SI's for the event will be available online before the event or at registration

6 VENUE

6.1 The At Home Regatta will be sailed in the waters of Glandore Harbour to include areas extending to High Island

7 THE COURSES

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will include details of courses to be sailed by all classes.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 For the Dragon & Squib classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe

9 SCORING

9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTION


10.1 Cost of lift-in and lift-out is not included in entry fee.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 11.1 A Working VHF Radio is mandatory for all keel boats in all GHYC racing events.
- 11.2 The PRO shall broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet including course information that cannot be displayed. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress for any claim for redress. This alters Rule 41.

12 PRIZES

12.1 The Race Committee will award Prizes to both the following (Details will be included in the Supplementary SI's):-



- 12.1.1 First Past the Post Entries
- 12.1.2 Those Entries using RYA NHC Handicap

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

14 INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.

15 Rights to Use Name and Likeness

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
