NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS

- 1.1 The Squib Summer Cup will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Under RRS 87 Squib class rule C10.2(b) is in effect
- 1.3 A boats handicap will be adjusted, using RYA NHC, after every race. A system of progressive handicapping, where each boat's handicap is automatically adjusted on the basis of performance in each race, will apply to each subsequent race. The act of handicap adjustment or failure to adjust will not be grounds for a request for redress this changes RRS 62.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

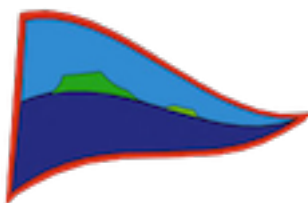
- 2.1 The Squib Summer Cup is open to the Squib class whose owner(s) is a paid up member(s) of GHYC
- 2.2 Helms must be paid up members of GHYC
- 2.3 Entries are only accepted on successful completion of the Entry Form, which must be delivered, at the noted Registration time, to the GHYC Club house with the Fees, unless paid on-line, required for the Event
- 2.4 Please check the club web site for Online Payment options
- 2.5 Late entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows: Squibs €20

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: 27th July 13:00 – 14:00 GHYC Club House
- 4.2 Racing Schedule:



4.2.1 A Maximum of 2 races per day will be attempted.

4.2.2 FG on each day will be 15:00hrs

4.2.3 No Start Signal after 17:00hrs

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The GHYC Standard Sailing Instructions(SI's) are already available and the SI Supplement for the event will be available online and at registration

6 VENUE

6.1 The Race will be sailed in the waters of Glandore Harbour to include areas extending to High Island

7 THE COURSES

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will include details of courses.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 For the Squib classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe

9 SCORING

9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 A Working VHF Radio is mandatory for all keel boats in all GHYC racing events.

10.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

10.3 The PRO shall broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet including course information that cannot be displayed. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress. This alters RRS Rule 41.

11 SAFETY REGULATIONS

11.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's)

All competitors shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

12 PRIZES

12.1 The Race Committee will award Prizes to both as below - Details will be included within the Supplementary SI's

12.1.2 Those Entries using RYA NHC Handicap

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the Race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

14 INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.

15 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
