

GLANDORE HARBOUR YACHT CLUB SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

For event: All 2020 League Series of Races for the Dragon class

NB - These Supplementary Sailing Instructions must be read in conjunction with the NOR and the GHYC Standard SI's.

1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

1.1 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 4 minutes' in the Race Signal AP. This changes RRS Race Signals AP

2 SCHEDULE OF RACES

2.1 The Racing Season will consist of the following series:

Dragons: Evening League, Summer League.

The Schedule of Races is detailed in Addendum 3. Check the GHYC website/calendar for changes.

2.2 One Race per fleet minimum attempted per day, maximum races per day as specified in the NOR

3 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be: Dragon – Code Flag D



4 RACING AREA AND MARKS

Addendum 2 of this SSI shows the location of the racing area and the approximate location and type of marks.

5 THE COURSES

The Course for each race will be given on the day of race using the marks listed on this SSI Addendum 2 and as shown on the map of Standard Race Marks Addendum 1 of this SSI.

- 5.1 Courses may be shortened in accordance with RRS Rule 32.2(a). "Shortened Course" may be broadcast on ch. 68, at the discretion of the PRO.
- 5.2 Courses Shortened, using the Code Flag S, by the shore based Race Officer will require a course to include the Harbour Mark within the course. Once the S Flag is displayed and the double Horn sounded, competitors will proceed to the Harbour Mark passing between it and the moveable shore based staff described in 6.1.1 in the direction from the previous mark, this adds to RRS Rule 32.2 (a)
- 5.3 Courses may also be shortened by the Race Committee displaying Code Flag F in the vicinity of a mark while making repetitive sound signals. Boats should round/pass the mark on the required



side and sail directly to the finishing line. Boats should cross the finish in the direction from the mark at which F is displayed. This adds to RRS Rule 32.2.

6 THE START

- 6.1 Starts may either use a shore based line as described in 6.2, or a line set on the water as described in 6.3. The choice of line will be announced on the day by the Race officer using VHF radio and may also be posted on the club noticeboard.
- 6.2 A moveable shore based red staff with a yellow reflective top and a flagged outer limit mark as described in Addendum 2 Starting Flags & Notes. An inner distance mark, red buoy with pole, may be positioned on or near the shore side of the line. Boats shall start between the flagged limit mark and the inner distance mark at the final crossing of the Start Line.
- 6.3 A line set between a flag on a club boat and a buoy (the pin end), the flag colour and buoy details to be announced on the day.
- 6.4 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

7 THE FINISH

7.1 The finishing line will usually be the same as the start line unless announced otherwise when the course is set, and unless the course is shortened.

8 TIME LIMITS

- 8.1 The Race Time Limit will be 75 minutes on Wednesday and 120 minutes on Saturdays
- 8.2 Finishing Window Time limit will be 15 minutes
- 8.3 Any Boat failing to finish within the Finishing Window will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

9 **SCORING**

- 9.1 The number of races that are required to be completed to constitute a series is defined in the NOR.
- 9.2 A boat that does not start due to the owner and/or helm and crew providing RO duty shall be scored average points based on scores from races completed. (ROD Race Officer Duty). A boat shall be scored DNE (non-excludable) if the owner or helm scheduled to provide RO duty for a race neither provides that duty nor arranges a suitable cover RO and informs the PRO at least four days prior to the event.
- 9.3 A boat that does not start due to attendance at another competition representing the club shall be scored average points based on scores from races completed (OAOC Owner Away at Other Competition)
- 9.4 Discards will be deducted from the Boats total score as follows:-

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies/Prize will be awarded for each League series on the last day of racing for the League series event, as follows:-
- 10.1.1 Event Trophy/Prize First past the post Helm & Crew of first 2 boats.
- 10.1.2 [Optional] Event Handicap Trophy/Prize RYA NHC Handicap prize for the Helm & Crew of the highest placed boat (excluding any boat that was a winner in the First Past the Post category).





SSI ADDENDUM 2a Map of Racing Area and Racing Marks


All marks are white poles except Sunk Rock which is a green navigational buoy.
