3	COMMUNICATION
3.1	The official notice board is located at Glandore Harbour Yacht Club, School Road, Rushanes, Glandore, Co Cork, P81 KN30

3.2	[DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel 16, 67, 68, 69 & 72
3.3	On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
3.4	[DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
4	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
<b>4.1</b> J1.1(4)*	The event is open to all boats of the International Dragon class that have current measurement certificates.
4.2	All Owners and Helms/Crew shall be paid up members of their National Dragon Association and their National Sailing Authority.
4.3	Eligible boats may enter the event by using the online Entry Form which can be found on the documents table for this event on the official notice board as mentioned above in 3.1.
4.4	Alternatively boats may request a printable Entry Form sent as an email attachment by emailing <u>dragoncaptain@glandoreyc.com</u> with Subject line: "Irish South Coast Dragon Championship 2021, which should then be completed and emailed back to the same email address.or posted to Dragon SC Champioship Entry, Glandore Harbour Yacht Club, School Road, Rushanes, Glandore, Co Cork, P81 KN30 by Friday 11 <sup>th</sup> June 2021
4.5	To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and <b>pay all fees</b> by 1100hrs on Friday 11 <sup>th</sup> June 2021.
4.6	Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid [measurement][rating] certificate.
4.7	Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: a person has tried to enter a boat and there have been problems in meeting all registration requirements that were outside their control.

13	COURSES	
13.1	The course(s) to be sailed will be as follows:

14	PENALTY SYSTEM	
14.1	RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.	
14.2	The right of appeal from a protest committee decision is denied as provided in RRS 70.5(b)	
15	SCORING	
15.2	<b>3</b> races are required to be completed to constitute a series	
15.3	(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.	
	(b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst excludable score.	
16	SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS	
16.1	Support person vessels shall be marked with the GHYC flag.	
17	CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS	
17.1	A chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules, provided that the race committee has approved her sail identification before the first race.	
18	BERTHING	
18.1	Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the harbour.	

19	HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS	
19.1	Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.	
20	DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS	
20.1	Keelboats shall not be cleaned below the waterline by any means during the event.

22	RISK STATEMENT	
22.1	RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.	
22.2	No responsibility shall be accepted by the OA, their directors, officers, members, servants or agents nor any sponsor, nor those officials or members connected with the Event for any loss, damage or any other claim of whatever nature however arising or caused in connection with the participation in or intended participation in the Irish National Dragon Championship event.	
23	INSURANCE	
23.1	Each competing Dragon Owner(s) and competing crews shall ensure that they are insured with adequate, valid, third party liability insurance including racing risk. All owners/competitors who sign / write their name at the bottom of the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.	
24	PRIZES	
24.1	<ul> <li>Prizes will be given as follows:</li> <li>The IDA South Coast Championship Perpetual Trophy (name??) will be awarded to the first boat overall.</li> <li>Prizes will be awarded to the helmsman and crew of the first three boats overall, and to the winner of each race, except that no helm and crew may win more than one race winner prize.</li> <li>Other prizes may be awarded at the OA's discretion.</li> </ul>	

25	RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS	
25.1	By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
