SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

The only signal that could be made ashore would be Abandon All Races which would be posted on the club noticeboard before racing was due to start.

2 SCHEDULE OF RACES

The Schedule of Races is detailed in the NOR. Check the GHYC website/calendar for changes.

3 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be: Squib – Code Flag Naval Numeral 9



Dragon – Code Flag D



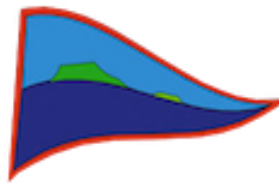
Cruisers – TBA on the day.

4 RACING AREA AND MARKS

The Racing area and Marks will be as described in Appendix 1

5 THE COURSES

- 5.1 The Course for each race will be announced for each race on VHF by the Committee Boat using the marks as shown on the map of Standard Race Marks Appendix 1 of this SI.
- 5.2 Courses may be shortened by the Race Committee displaying Code Flag F in the vicinity of a mark while making repetitive sound signals. Boats should round/pass the mark on the required side and sail directly to the finishing line. Boats should cross the finish in the direction from the mark at which F is displayed. This adds to RRS Rule 32.2.
- 5.3 At the discretion of the Race Officer, an announcement when describing the course may be made over the VHF which prohibits boats from passing through the Start Line after starting, and/or from passing through the Finish Line except when finishing, for the duration of a race.



6 THE START

- 6.1 The starting line will be between a staff with an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and a flagged Outer Limit Mark.
- 6.2 The race committee boat may have a buoy/dinghy attached to the stern which shall be considered part of the mark
- 6.3 An Inner Limit Mark, to be described on the day when courses are described, may be positioned between the Outer Limit Mark and the Committee boat near to the Committee boat, and if so boats shall start between the Outer limit mark and the Inner Limit mark at the final crossing of the Start Line.
- 6.4 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

7 THE FINISH

- 7.1 The finishing line will be between a staff with a blue flag on the Race Committee boat and a flagged limit mark, unless the course is shortened at another mark using flag S.
- 7.2 Boats that have finished a race shall not re-cross the finishing line in any direction except for some unavoidable cause until all boats have finished that race. The Race Committee may lodge a protest. This changes RRS 60.
- 7.3 The Race Committee may display class flags to indicate which classes are finishing.

8 TIME LIMITS

- 8.1 The Race Time Limit will be 120 minutes

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The number of races that are required to be completed to constitute a series is defined in the NOR.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies/Prize will be as described in the NOR

11 SAFETY

- 11.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's). All competitors shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

12 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 12.1 Protest forms are available from the race officer at the race office. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.
- 12.2 For each class, the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- 12.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses and where the hearings will be held.

13 ARBITRATION

- 13.1 Appendix T will apply
