## NOTICE OF REGATTA

Note: This NOR is for Squibs only, there are separate NORs for the Dragon class (Lar Casey Cup) and the Dinghy classes.

### **1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS**

- 1.1 The Glandore Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) the Irish Sailing Prescriptions. Also respective Class Rules will apply unless specifically advised otherwise..
- 1.2 The regatta will be conducted to conform with the rules relating to Covid-19 as prescribed from time to time by the Irish Sailing Assn and by GHYC
- 1.3 Under RRS 87 Squib class rule C10.2(b) is in effect

### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

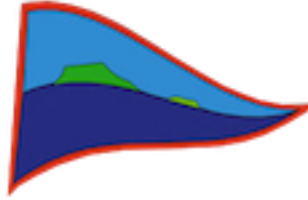
- 2.1 The Regatta is open to boats of Squib classes whose owner is a paid-up member of GHYC.
- 2.2 Helms must be paid up members of GHYC
- 2.3 Entries are only accepted on successful completion of the online Entry Form, which must be submitted by 23:59 the day before the first race with payment of the fees for the race online using EPP.
- 2.4 Late entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority.

### **3 FEES**

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:
  - 3.1.1 Squibs €15 unless the Season Fee has been paid.
- 3.2 Fees should be paid online using EasyPaymentsPlus accessible via the GHYC Web Home Page.

### **4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Registration: Registration for Squibs will be online via EPP.



4.2 Racing Schedule: there will be a single race for the Squib class.

4.2.1 One race per Fleet will be held on the day with First Gun times as follows:-

- Squibs First Gun will be at 13:15

4.2.2 A Minimum of 3 boats is required before a start will be scheduled.

## **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

5.1 The Sailing Instructions(SI's) for the event will be available on line at <http://glandoreyc.com/racing/racinginformation>

## **6 VENUE**

6.1 The Regatta/Race will be sailed in the waters of Glandore Harbour and Glandore Bay to include areas extending to High Island

## **7 THE COURSES**

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will include details of courses.

## **8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe.

## **9 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

9.1 A Working VHF Radio is mandatory for all boats in all GHYC racing events.

9.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

9.3 The PRO may broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress for any claim for redress.

## **10 SAFETY REGULATIONS**

10.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's)

All competitors shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

## **11 PRIZES**

11.1 The Regatta/Race Committee will award Prizes to the following as below - Details will be included within the SI's

11.1.1 Squib fleets First Past the Post results for each class.

11.1.2 Squibs 1st place wins the perpetual Regatta Cup and takeaway prizes, 2<sup>nd</sup> boat wins takeaway prizes.



## **12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

## **13 INSURANCE**

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.

## **14 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

- 14.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

## **15 SCORING**

- 15.1 One race is required to complete a series.

## **16 ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY**
