## NOTICE OF REGATTA

### **1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS**

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Irish Sailing Prescriptions. Also respective Class Rules will apply unless specifically advised otherwise.
- 1.2 Under RRS 87 Dragon Class Rule 13.30 is not in effect

### **2 ADVERTISING**

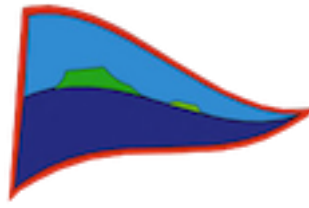
- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 This event is open to the following classes:-
  - 3.1.1 International Dragon
- 3.2 All boat owners and helms, except visitors to Glandore, must be paid up members of Glandore Harbour Yacht Club. Visitors shall be paid up members of their respective fleet National Associations.
- 3.3 Visitors will be granted temporary membership of Glandore Harbour Yacht Club for the duration of the event.
- 3.4 **NOTE** Visiting boats that will need to be craned in and out must note the following. This event is being held one week before the Rose Bowl Regatta, and the crane-in for visiting boats will be on the 13<sup>th</sup> August for this event, however the next available crane out will be organised for the 20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup> August for the Rose Bowl Regatta.
  - 3.1 Eligible boats may enter the event by using the online Entry Form which can be found on the documents table (insert link) for this event on the GHYC Web site. Entries are only accepted on successful completion of the Entry Form, and upon payment of the fees for the series at registration unless already paid on-line.
  - 3.2 Late entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority.

### **4 FEES**

- 4.1 For a visitors or club members who have not paid the Annual Race Fee the required fee is as follows:
  - 4.1.1 Dragons €50
- 4.2 **NOTE:** The costs of Crane-in/out are not included in the entry fee. These will be €70 for each lift, bearing in mind para 3.4 above. These should be paid in cash at the launch. To help us with planning please let us know that you would wish to be craned in and/or out by no later than the 8th August.

## 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Crane in/Out is all from Union Hall Pier and will be as follows: -
- 5.1.1 Crane In August 13th from 0900
- 5.2 Registration: Saturday August 13th 10:00 – 11:00 at the GHYC Club House
- 5.3 Competitors Briefing Saturday August 13th 11:00 GHYC Club House
- 5.4 Racing Schedule
- 5.4.1 Saturday August 13th
    - 5.4.1.1 First Gun Dragons 13:00
    - 5.4.1.2 Three races will be attempted
  - 5.4.2 Sunday August 14th
    - 5.4.2.1 First Gun Dragons 10:00
    - 5.4.2.2 Two races will be attempted
    - 5.4.2.3 It is planned to be back at moorings by 12.00 noon.
- 5.5 Rose Bowl for information (Subject to event NOR)
- 5.5.1 Crane In August 20th from 0900 (lifting for washing may be possible)
  - 5.5.2 Crane Out August 21st from 1600

## 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The GHYC Sailing Instructions(SI) for the event will be available on the club website prior to the event.

## 7 VENUE

- 7.1 The Regatta/Race will be sailed in the waters of Glandore Harbour to include Glandore Bay depending upon conditions.

## 8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 The Sailing Instructions will include details of courses to be sailed by all classes. The intention is that most courses will be windward/leeward courses.

## 9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe

## 10 SCORING

- 10.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute the series.

## 11 MOORING

- 11.1 Visitor berthing for this event will be advised prior to Crane In of visitor boats. **NOTE** as mentioned in 3.4 above visiting boats will be allocated a mooring for the week from 13<sup>th</sup> August to 21<sup>st</sup> August.

## 12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1 A Working VHF Radio is mandatory for all keel boats in all GHYC racing events.
- 12.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.



- 12.3 The PRO shall broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress. This alters RRS Rule 41.

### **13 SAFETY REGULATIONS**

13.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's)

All competitors shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

### **14 PRIZES**

14.1 The Regatta/Race Committee will award Prizes as follows:

14.2 The Lar Casey Cup will be presented to the winning boat.

14.3 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> overall will be awarded takeaway prizes, and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in the local Dragon fleet will also receive takeaway prizes. There will be a prize for the best boat on each day. There may be a system to award prizes to lower placed boats that have already received a prize.

14.4 The main Prizegiving will be at Casey's Bar after racing finishes on Sunday 14th August. Time to be advised a.m. on Sunday 14th August. There will be a prizegiving at Casey's for the best daily boat on Saturday.

### **15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

15.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

### **16 INSURANCE**

16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.

### **17 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

### **18 ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY**

As part of the venue's commitment to reducing the environmental impact of the event, we request that competitors, team leaders, coaches, volunteers, race officers and all stakeholders follow the Irish Sailing event sustainability guidelines. As part of that initiative competitors are asked not to bring disposable plastic water bottles. There is a Refill Point in the Club Yard for re-useable water bottles.
