NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS

- 1.1 The Event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 International Dragon Class rule 13.30 (crew weight restriction) shall not apply, and rule 13.10 is modified to permit changes in the number of crew during an event or series.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Race is open to boats of the Dragon and Squib Classes class whose owners are paid-up members of GHYC.
- 2.2 Helms must be paid up members of GHYC
- 2.3 Entries are only accepted from those Dragons owners that have paid the Dragon Annual Race Fee, and from Squib Owners who have paid either the Annual Race Fee or the individual race fee.

3 FEES

- 3.1 For Dragons and Squibs this is a club race where the fee is included in the Annual Race Fee for 2022, and €15 for Squib owners who are paying per race.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: online
Racing Schedule: the racing will take place on the 16th July 2022
- 4.2 for the race from Glandore to Castletownshend:
 - 4.2.1 Dragons FG will be 11:00
 - 4.2.2 Squibs FG will be 11:10
- 4.3 for the race from Castletownshend to Glandore FG times to be agreed in Mary Ann's on the day.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions(SI's) for the event will be available on line at <http://glandoreyc.com/racing/> no later than the day before the race.



6 VENUE

- 6.1 Between Glandore Harbour and Castletownshend Harbour.

7 THE COURSES

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions (SI) will include details of courses.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe.

9 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 9.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's)
- 9.2 All competitors shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 The Dragon class winner will receive the perpetual Mary Ann's Dragon Shield, and take away prizes.
- 10.2 The Squib class winner will receive the perpetual Mary Ann's Squib Shields, and take away prizes.
- 10.3 Second and third place boats will receive takeaway prizes.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

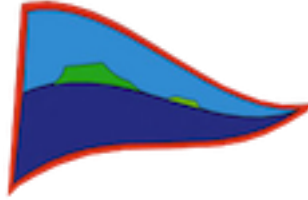
- 11.1 A Working VHF Radio is mandatory for all keel boats in all GHYC racing events.
- 11.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
- 11.1 The PRO shall broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress. This alters RRS Rule 41.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the Race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Race

13 INSURANCE

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.



14 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

15 ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILIT

- 15.1 As part of the venue's commitment to reducing the environmental impact of the event, we request that competitors, team leaders, coaches, volunteers, race officers and all stakeholders follow the Irish Sailing event sustainability guidelines. Details published here:
