NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Under RRS 87 Squib class rule C10.2(b) is in effect

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the Squib class whose owner(s) is/are a paid-up members of GHYC.
- 2.2 Helms must be paid up members of GHYC
- 2.3 Entries are only accepted on successful completion of the online Entry Form including the Race Agreement, along with payment of the Fee

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:
 - 3.1.1 €30 for this event, unless the 2021 whole Season Race Fee has been paid.
 - 3.1.2 Payments should be made using the Online payment system EPP on the GHYC website Home Page and should be received no later than 23:59 on Monday 2nd August



4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Racing Schedule:-

4.1.1 A Maximum of 3 races p will be attempted, unless the PRO/RO advises otherwise as per SSI.

4.1.2 FG oy will be 17:45hrs

4.1.3 No Start Signal after 20:30hrs

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The SI's for the event i will be available online before the event at <http://glandoreyc.com/racing/>

6 VENUE

6.1 The Summer Cup Regatta will be sailed in the waters of Glandore Harbour to include areas extending to Adam Island

7 THE COURSES

7.1 The SSI's will include details of courses to be sailed by all classes.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe

9 SCORING

9.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 A working VHF Radio is mandatory for all keel boats in all GHYC racing events.

10.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

10.3 The PRO may broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress for any claim for redress.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded based on First Past the Post results.

11.2 Details will be included in the Supplementary SI's.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta



13 INSURANCE

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.

14 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

- 14.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

15 ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY

- 15.1 As part of the venue's commitment to reducing the environmental impact of the event, we request that competitors, team leaders, coaches, volunteers, race officers and all stakeholders follow the Irish Sailing event sustainability guidelines.
