



GLANDORE INN ROSE BOWL FOR DRAGONS & SQUIBS AUGUST 19th & 20th 2023 GLANDORE HARBOUR YACHT CLUB SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

These Sailing Instructions must be read in conjunction with the NOR

1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Flag signals will not be flown ashore. Postponements or abandonments will be posted on the club electronic noticeboards.

2 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 2.1 The Schedule of Races is detailed in NOR.
- 2.2 In the event that the weather prevents the planned number of races being held on the first day, the schedule for the second day may be altered. Check the GHYC website/Racing Information page for amendments to the NOR and also relevant WhatsApp groups.

3 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be: Squib – Code Flag Naval Numeral 9

Dragon – Code Flag D

4 RACING AREA AND MARKS

- 4.1 The racing area will be in Glandore Bay or Glandore Outer Harbour depending on conditions
- 4.2 Marks 1 and 2 will be Yellow Cylindrical
- 4.3 SP will be a Red buoy with a white flag.
- 4.4 Start Line outer limit mark (OLM) will be a red Buoy with a Red Flag, Finish line OLM will be a red buoy with a red flag unless announced otherwise.
- 4.5 The race committee signal boat may have a buoy/dinghy attached to the stern which shall be considered part of the mark

5 THE COURSES

Addendum 1 contains the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

- 5.1 Each Race may be either one or two laps, a board shall be displayed on the Committee Boat before each warning signal.



- 5.2 At the discretion of the PRO, a Spreader mark may be added to the course, shown as SP on Addendum 1. The Spreader Mark will only be rounded on the first loop of the course, however if in the event that it remains there for the subsequent rounds, then it should be ignored.
- 5.3 No boat after starting shall cross the Finish line except when finishing a race
- 5.4 Courses may be shortened in accordance with RRS Rule 32.2(a). "Shortened Course" may be broadcast on ch. 68, at the discretion of the PRO.
- 5.5 Courses may also be shortened by the Race Committee displaying Code Flag F (see below) in the vicinity of a mark while making repetitive sound signals. Boats should round/pass the mark on the required side and sail directly to the finishing line. Boats should cross the finish in the direction from the mark at which F is displayed. This adds to RRS Rule 32.2.



- 5.6 Flag F:

6 THE START

- 6.1 The Starting Line shall be between a staff with an orange flag on the Race Committee boat at the starboard end and an Outer Limit Mark (OLM) at the port end, see Addendum 1 for further info.
- 6.2 An Inner Limit Mark (ILM), shape and colour to be identified on the day, shall be positioned between the Outer Limit Mark and the Race Committee boat near to the Committee boat, and boats shall start between the Outer Limit mark and the Inner Limit mark at the final crossing of the Start Line. The ILM ranks as a Starting Mark, but is not necessarily on the Starting Line.
- 6.3 Boats whose warning signal has not been sounded are requested to keep away from the starting area.
- 6.4 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

7 THE FINISH

- 7.1 The finishing line will be between the staff with a blue flag on the committee boat and an Outer Limit Mark as described in Addendum 1 – unless the course is shortened as in SI 5.4 & SI 5.5
- 7.2 Boats shall cross the finish line completely after finishing. Any boat failing to do this shall be deemed not to have finished unless she subsequently finishes. This changes RRS 28.1
- 7.3 Boats that have finished shall not re-cross the finishing line in any direction except for some unavoidable cause. The Race Committee may lodge a protest that the boat had continued to sail the course and had not finished (see Definitions/Finish).
- 7.4 The Race Committee Boat, may display a class flag(s) to indicate which class(es) are finishing.

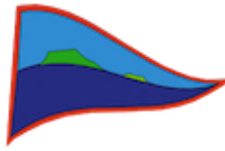
8 TIME LIMITS

- 8.1 The Race Time Limit will be 90 minutes
- 8.2 Finishing Window will be 15 minutes from the time the first boat has finished.
- 8.3 Any Boat failing to finish within the Finishing Window will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The number of races that are required to be completed to constitute a series is defined in the NOR.
- 9.2 Discards will be deducted from the Boats total score as follows:-

Number of Races	Discards
4 or more	1



10 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

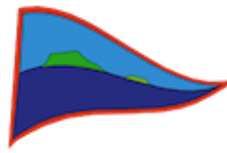
- 10.1 Protest forms are available at the race office. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.
- 10.2 For each class, the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- 10.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses and where the hearings will be held.

11 ARBITRATION

- 11.1 Appendix T will apply.

12 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 12.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's). All competitors shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

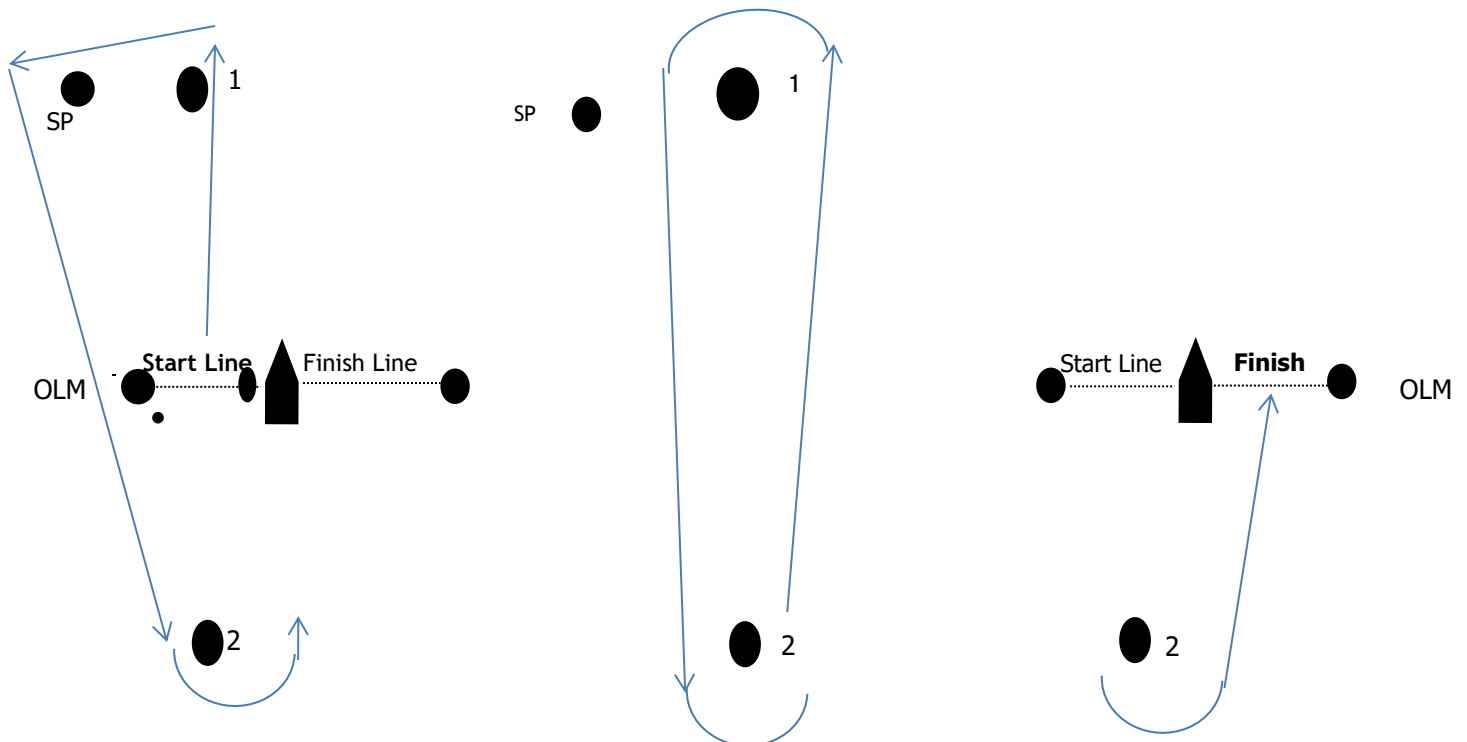

A TWO LAP COURSE: Start, Mark 1 to P, SP Mark to P, Mark 2 to P, Mark 1 to P, Mark 2 to P, Finish

The number of rounds will be displayed on the Committee boat at or before the warning signal for each class.

NOTE: SI 5.3 No boat after starting shall cross the Finish line except when finishing a race.
