NOTICE OF REGATTA

1 RULES & HANDICAP SYSTEMS

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Under RRS 87 Squib class rule C10.2(b) is in effect
- 1.3 International Dragon Class rule 13.30 (crew weight restriction) shall not apply, and rule 13.10 is modified to permit changes in the crew and number of crew (max four) during an event or series.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

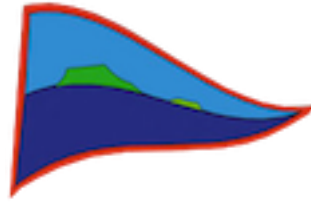
- 2.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the Squib and Dragon classes whose owner(s) is/are paid-up members of GHYC.
- 2.2 Helms must be paid up members of GHYC and Dragon owners shall be paid up members of the Irish Dragon Association (IDA) for 2024.
- 2.3 Three boats in a class are required to hold the race for that class.
- 2.4 Entries should be done at briefing.

3 FEES

- 3.1 For club members the fee for this race is included in the Annual Race Fee. For visitors or club members who have not paid the Annual Race Fee the required fees are as follows:
 - 3.1.1 Dragons €50
 - 3.1.2 Squib €20
- 3.2 **NOTE:** The costs of Crane-in and Crane-out are not included in the entry fee. These will up to €100 for each lift, depending on number of boats requesting lifts. These should be paid in cash at the launch/recovery. To help us with planning please let us know that you would wish to be craned in and/or out by no later than the 23rd August. **(31/08/2024 Saturday Crane in Morning Visiting Boats for Rose Bowl Event**
1/09/2024 Sunday evening Crane out Visiting Boats for Rose Bowl Event
- 3.3 Members fees should be paid via [Easy Payment Plus](#) (EPP) when completing the Entry Form at briefing.
- 3.4 Guests who do not have an account with EPP, can make payment at briefing.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Crane in/Out is all from Union Hall Pier and will be as follows: -
 - 4.1.1 Crane In August 31th from 0900
 - 4.1.2 Crane Out September 01st from 1600
- 4.2 Competitors Briefing Saturday August 31st 11:00 at GHYC Club House
- 4.3 Racing Schedule



- 4.3.1 Saturday August 31st
 - 4.3.1.1 First Gun Dragons 13:00
 - 4.3.1.2 First Gun Squibs 13:10
 - 4.3.1.3 Three races will be attempted for each fleet
- 4.3.2 Sunday September 1st
 - 4.3.2.1 First Gun Dragons 12:00
 - 4.3.2.2 First Gun Squibs 12:10
 - 4.3.2.3 Two races will be attempted for each fleet
 - 4.3.2.4 No Warning Signal after 15:30

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The SI's for the event will be available online before the event at <http://glandoreyc.com/racing-information/>

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The Regatta/Race will be sailed in the waters of Glandore Harbour to include Glandore Bay depending upon conditions.

7 THE COURSES

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions will include details of courses to be sailed by all classes.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 For the Dragon & Squib classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by One-Turn Penalty, including tack & gybe.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 1 discard will be applied after 4 races are completed.

10 MOORING

- 10.1 Visitor berthing for this event will be advised at Crane In of visitor boats
- 10.2 Boats should aim to have their own means of getting between shore and boats, however a water taxi may be available for the duration of the regatta/race before and after racing and to schedule at other times. See SI Supplement for Event

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

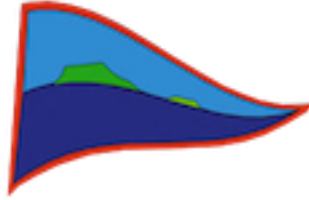
- 11.1 A Working VHF Radio is mandatory for all keel boats in all GHYC racing events.
- 11.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
- 11.3 The PRO shall broadcast on Channel 68 general information regarding racing to the fleet. Failure to broadcast this information, or to hear it, shall not be grounds for redress. This alters RRS Rule 41.

12 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 12.1 Personal Floatation Devices (PFD)
- 12.2 All competitors shall wear PFD at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. Wet suits and dry suits are not PFDs. This alters RRS Rule 40

13 PRIZES

- 13.1 Rose Bowl Trophies/Prize will be awarded as follows:



13.1.1 Event Trophy/Prize (Each Class) – Perpetual Glandore Inn Rose Bowl Trophies and keeper prizes for First place boats. Keeper prizes for Second and Third place boats.

13.1.2 Keeper prizes for the best GHYC boat in each class unless already a winner 1st, 2nd or 3rd in which case awarded to next best placed GHYC boat.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

15 INSURANCE

15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party liability insurance including racing risk.

16 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

16.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

17 ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY

17.1 As part of the venue's commitment to reducing the environmental impact of the event, we request that competitors, team leaders, coaches, volunteers, race officers and all stakeholders follow the Irish Sailing event sustainability guidelines. 17.2 As part of that initiative competitors are asked not to bring disposable plastic water bottles. There is a Refill Point in the Club Yard for reuseable water bottles.
