

GLANDORE HARBOUR YACHT CLUB SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Autumn 2024 League Series of Races for Mixed Dinghy classes

NB - These Sailing Instructions must be read in conjunction with the NOR

1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE n/a

2 SCHEDULE

- 2.1 The dates are as described in the NOR.
- 2.2 One race minimum attempted per day, maximum races per day as specified in the NOR.

3 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be: Letter "M"

4 RACING AREA AND MARKS

- 4.1 The racing area will be within Glandore Harbour.
- 4.2 Marks will be red buoys with a flag staff, however if another type of mark is used on any day this will be described at the daily briefing.

5 THE COURSES

- 5.1 The course for each race will be decided by the Race Officer (RO) on the day of racing. The course and the side on which each mark is to be left, will be notified at the briefing prior to each day's racing and may be modified by the Race Officer on the Committee boat.
- 5.2 At the discretion of the RO, a Spreader mark may be added to the course. The Spreader Mark shall be rounded on the same side (Port or Starboard) as the first Mark. The Spreader Mark will only be rounded on the first loop of the course. The RO may advise the Fleet/s of the addition of the Spreader Mark during the onshore briefing and/or via the noticeboard on the Committee boat.
- 5.3 Courses may be shortened by the Race Committee displaying Code Flag F in the vicinity of a mark while making repetitive sound signals. Boats should round/pass the mark on the required side and sail directly to the finishing line. Boats should cross the finish in the direction from the mark at which F is displayed. This adds to RRS Rule 32.2.

6 THE START

- 6.1 The start line will be between an orange flag on the Committee boat and a fixed or laid outer mark.
- 6.2 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

7 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a blue flag on the committee boat and an outer distance mark.

8 TIME LIMITS

8.1 The Race Time Limit will be 30 minutes.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The number of races that are required to be completed to constitute a series is defined in the NOR.
- 9.3 Rule A5.3 will apply.
- 9.3 Discards are as set out in the NOR.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Trophies/Prize to be awarded on the last day of racing for the League series are as set out in the NOR.
- 10.1.1 Prizes to be awarded will be determined by the Race Committee.
